**Profile: Peter D'Alena**

Peter is all about seeing – both in photography and in his profession as an ophthalmologist. Born in New York City, he grew up going to PS#4, attended high school on Long Island and graduated from CCNY, now known as CUNY, where, not surprisingly, he majored in biology and chemistry.

"I loved growing up in New York and loved school, especially the sciences.

Really I studied all the time. It wasn't until I was about 13 years old that I got my first camera. It was a box camera that I shared with my sister. At the time we would take primarily family pictures.

Peter graduated at the time of the Korean War, was drafted into the Army and as he describes it, "lucked out by being stationed at Fort Knox doing medical research." Medical school at Tulane followed and then a residency in Ophthalmology at UCSF.

"I had a solo practice in San Jose for 35 years," Peter says, "and now I serve as locum tenens filling in for docs on vacation plus teaching one day a week at the VA Hospital in Livermore.

"It wasn't until ten or so years ago that I got interested in photography and I like to photograph just about anything. I still shoot film with my Nikon and I love to travel. The Camera Club provides me with critiques which are very helpful."

Peter claims his computer skills are zero, but he's getting ready to start tackling all that comes with "becoming digital."
